3. Date:

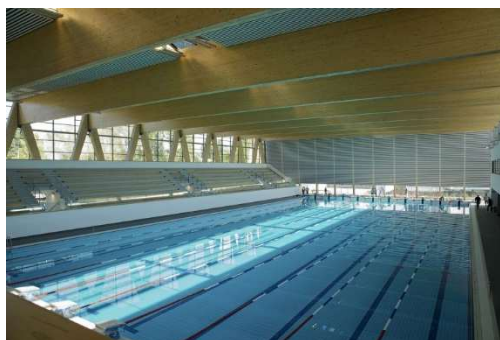
23rd – 24th of NOVEMBER 2024. (Saturday – Sunday)

Indoor pool, 50 m long with 10 lanes; Electric time keeping system;

Water temperature: 26±1°C

6. Registration process:

The competition is governed by CMAS Finswimming Rules, by CMAS Finswimming Youth World Cup Rules and by the present Specific Rules that every athlete - with his/her enrolment – affirms to know and agrees to strictly follow.

Registration

All registrations of athletes for events must be submitted only through electronic system.

Application forms can be used for preliminary entry, accommodation and airport transit.

Registration available only through the webpage <https://www.sportdata.org/cmas/>
Opening date of registration is 29rd September 2024. End of registration date is 10th November 2024.

Each competitor can take part in a maximum of four (4) individual races and two (2) relays. Each National Team or Club can enrol a maximum of four (4) swimmers for each individual race.

7. Registration tutorial:

In order to register - you need an account.

Users who have already registered an account in the CMAS system, please re-use your account. In this case you can also re-use all competitors, coaches, referees and officials data previously submitted. Steps of registration for competitors, coaches, referees and officials:

- Log in using your account
- Check if the team data is correct and up to date.
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials.
- In the event calendar go to the event you want to register for, click on the “Registration” button.
- On the bottom of the registration page you will find the functions to add new entries.
- Register your competitors / teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees and officials.
- All your registrations will be submitted to a waiting list for validation. After the payment process is finished, your registrations will be approved and you will be notified by email.
- You can find an overview about all your registrations at “My current entries”. There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.
- Please also check out the “Other Items” section of the event. The organizer may also provide here additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

- In 2024, you need to enter all categories of people who will attend the competition, not only the competitors.
- From now on, we will use the system to print the accreditation to access the swimming pool. For this reason, besides the competitors, you need to enter all members of your club:
 - Competitors
 - Coaches
 - Judges
 - Officials (all categories).
- Note: the registration of non-competitors is free of charge. No CMAS fees will be charged for the categories of Coaches, Referees and all Officials. To finish, the ID photo must be uploaded, whatever the category.

- After the deadline, the accreditations will be printed and sent to the organizing committee, and you will receive them upon arrival.

Fees of registration

CMAS Fees

For the Youth World Cup event each competitor must pay CMAS fee, fixed annually by CMAS.

- 24 € for each round.
Please note that the names of relay members must be entered during individual registration process even if they swim only relay. According to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on place before the beginning of competition.
These fees will be paid at the end of the registration process online by credit card.

b . Miscellaneous

- Fees paid for races not performed will not be reimbursed
- Penalties will apply for late enrolments after deadline according registration planning. Bank information is confidential. It will be sent to you upon request by mail at: cmaswcyouth@kvsc.info

c . Organisation Fees

The procedures of all expenditures regarding the competition (accommodation fee, inscription fees etc.) are paid directly to organising committee according to the instructions communicated below: cmaswcyouth@kvsc.info

Inscription fees are:

- 24 € for each club;
- 17 € per each relay;
- 8,70 € per each individual distance

Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.

Late enrolments are not accepted because registration is managed by CMAS system during registration planning.

Payment should be made in cash by the registration or by direct bank transfer.

Participation rules and events

1. Races by categories are the follows:

Category “C” (14-15 years; boys and girls):

AP/Apnea: 50 m

IM/Immersion: 100 m, 200 m

SF/Surface: 50 m, 100 m, 200 m, 400 m, 800 m,

BF/Bi Fins: 50 m, 100 m, 200 m, 400 m

Relays: 4X50 m SB (mixed), 4x100 m SF

Category “D” (12-13 years; boys and girls):

SF/Surface: 50 m, 100 m, 200 m, 400 m

BF/Bi Fins: 50 m, 100 m, 200 m, 400 m
Relays: 4X50 m SB (mixed)

Category "E" (10-11 years; boys and girls):

SF/Surface: 50 m, 100 m, 200 m
BF/Bi Fins: 50 m, 100 m, 200 m
Relays: 4X50 m SB (mixed), 4X50 m BF (mixed)

2. Participation rules:

Participating in higher age group is allowed.

Timekeeping system:

Electronic, Colorado system.

Checking equipments:

The equipment (fins, bottles, snorkels) checking procedure will be in the swimming pool 15:00-20:00 22nd November (during the registration).

Classifications:

There will be classification for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries.

Individual: There will be, for every distance, per category men & women. Swimmers registered by Clubs or National Teams are in this classification.

Club: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual point (boys and girls, only registered by clubs). Three separate Club Classification will be made. Overall C – D – E categories, boys C – D – E categories, girls C – D- E categories.

National Teams: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual point (boys and girls, only register by National Teams). Three separate National Teams Classification will be made. Overall C – D – E categories, boys C – D – E categories, girls C – D- E categories.

Countries ranking:

The Countries Ranking will be made in accordance with points 1.10 and 1.12 by the total amount of the individual points (C – D – E categories, boys and girls) of National Teams.

If a National Federation does not enrol its National team, the best two results by club in accordance with points 1.10 and 1.12 at each distance, at each category (C – D – E categories, boys and girls,) will go for the Countries ranking.

Awards:

- Gold, silver and bronze medals for each distance. Per event and category men and women
- The first Club and National teams of the overall, boys and girls classifications will receive a cup.
- All participant Clubs and National Teams will receive an award.

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the involved athletes must be at organizing staff's disposal at the right time.

During ceremonies awarded athletes must wear official uniforms of their teams.

Responsibility:

The Organizing Federation, the Organizing Committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge aren't responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition. these rules as a condition of participation.

Additional note:

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organizers.

Participating teams will get all information about the changes in time. Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their equipment complete at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

Accommodation and transportation:

The organizing committee offers two options of accommodation:

Hotel*:** 125 €/person (rooms with 2 beds)

Hotel**:** 140 €/person (rooms with 2 beds)

Single room extra price: 30€/person/night

The price includes the full board accommodation. Full board means: 2 nights (Friday – Saturday) and meals from Friday 22nd dinner to Sunday 24th November lunch).

Extra day cost with full board accommodation:

Hotel*:** 60 €/person (rooms with 2 beds)

Hotel**:** 70 €/person (rooms with 2 beds)

The cost of transportation from Liszt Ferenc International Airport (Arrival and Departure): 55€ / person. If transportation is needed, please fill the Enclosure 3 form.

accepted with the new, filled document, that must be sent to the linked e-mail address.
