Barranquilla is the capital district of the Atlántico department in Colombia. It is located near the Caribbean Sea and is the largest city and third port in the Caribbean coast region; as of 2022, it had a population of 1,906,319 making it Colombia's fourth-most populous city after Bogotá, Medellín, and Cali.

Barranquilla lies strategically next to the delta of the Magdalena River, 7.5 km (4.7 mi) (originally 25 km (16 mi) before rapid urban growth) from its mouth at the Caribbean Sea, serving as a port for river and maritime transportation within Colombia. It is also the main economic center of the Atlántico department in Colombia. The city is the core of the Barranquilla metropolitan area, with a population of over 3 million, which also includes the municipalities of Soledad, Galapa, Malambo, and Puerto Colombia.

Barranquilla was legally established as a town on April 7, 1813, although it dates from at least 1629. It grew into an important port, serving as a haven for immigrants from Europe, especially during and immediately following World War I and World War II, when waves of additional immigrants from the Middle East and Asia arrived. Barranquilla became Colombia's main port, and with its level of industrialization and modernity, it earned the nickname "Colombia's Golden Gate" (Spanish: La Puerta de Oro de Colombia). In the 1940s, Barranquilla was the second-largest city in Colombia and one of the most modern cities in the Caribbean and in South America; later local administrations, due to widespread corruption in their ranks, brought about a decline in the standard of living. As government investment increased in other Colombian cities, Barranquilla's national position was eclipsed.

Barranquilla has hosted the 2018 Central American and Caribbean Games. The city is home to one of the most important folk and cultural festivals of Colombia, the Carnival of Barranquilla, which was declared a National Cultural Heritage by the Congress of Colombia in 2001 and recognized by UNESCO in 2003.















Dénomination

The COLOMBIAN UNDERWATER FEDERATION- FEDECAS – authorized by CMAS – invites all interested Federations and Clubs to participate in the XVIII CMAS Finswimming World Cup 2024, Round 5 organized between 4th – 6th October of 2024 in Barranquilla-Colombia.

1. Registration process

The competition is governed by CMAS Finswimming Rules, by CMAS Finswimming World Cup Rules and by the present Specific Rules that every athlete - with his/her enrolment - affirms to know and agrees to strictly follow.

1. Registration

All registration of athletes for events must be submitted <u>only through electronic</u> <u>way</u>. Application forms can be used only for accommodation.

1.9 of rules: Each competitor can take part in a maximum of four (4) individual races and two (2) relays.

2. Registration Tutorial:

For registration, you need an account.

Users who already have registered an account <u>in our system</u>, please re-use your account. In this case, you can also re-use all competitors, coaches, referees and officials' data.

For event registration of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials please follow these steps:

• Log in with your account.















- Check your team data. Please check if the data is correct and up to date.
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials.
- In the event calendar go to the event you want to register for, click on the "Registration" button of the event you want to register.
- On the bottom of the entries site, you will see the functions to make new entries.
- Register your competitors/teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees and officials.
- All your registrations will go first on a waiting list in order to validate them. After the payment process is finished, your registrations will be approved, and you will be notified by email.
- You can find an overview of all your registrations at "My current entries".
 There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.
- Please also check out the "Other Items" section of the event. The organizer may also provide here additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

3. Fees of registration

a. CMAS Fees



For each round or Golden Final, in order to participate, each competitor must pay CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS.

- 24 € for participation fees by each round.

Please note that the names of relay members must be entered during the registration process on the base of individual registration even if they swim only relay and even according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on site before the beginning of competition.

These fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online, by credit card.

b. <u>Miscellaneous</u>

- Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.
- Penalties will apply for late enrolments after the deadline according to the registration planning.

c. Organisation Fees

The procedures of all expenditures regarding the competition (accommodation fee, inscription fees etc.) are paid directly to the organising committee according to the instructions communicated below:

-Inscription fees are:

- 24 € or 26 us dollars for each club.
- 17 € or 20 us dollars for each relay.
- 8,70 € or 9 us dollars for each individual distance.
- Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.
- Late enrolments are not accepted because registration is managed by CMAS system during registration planning.


































Participation rules and races

1. Races and Categories are as follows:

SENIOR (Cat. "A") M/W

50 m AP., 100 m IM., 200 m IM., 400 m IM.,

50 m SF., 100 m SF., 200 m SF., 400 m SF., 800 m SF., 1500 m SF.,

50 m BF., 100 m BF., 200 m BF., 400 m BF.

Relay: 4 x 100 m SF., Relay: 4 x 100 m SB mixed.

JUNIOR (Cat. "B, C, D") B/G

50 m AP., 100 m IM., 200 m IM., 400 m IM.,

2. Competition place

The competition will take place at Complejo **Acuático Eduardo Movilla**, Cra. 55 #52 - 48, Norte, Barranquilla.

The swimming pool has a length of 50m, a width of 21 m and eight lanes 25 m and ten lanes and a depth of 2m. The temperature of the water is $26^{\circ}C$ (+ $1^{\circ}C$).

3. Timekeeping system

The timekeeping system will conduct time recording through Daktronics electronic time and recording system.

4. Checking equipment and bottle refills

The judges are authorized to control swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions.













5. Classifications

Classifications will be based on times registered by the timekeepers; results will be complied according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

- 3.1. There will be classifications for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries
- 3.2. <u>Individual</u>: There will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for Senior and Junior, men and women. Swimmers registered by Clubs or National Teams are in this classification.
- 3.3. <u>Club</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification will be made also for senior men, senior women, junior boys and junior girls.
- 3.4. <u>National Teams</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification will be made also for men, women, junior boys, junior girls.

3.5. Countries Ranking:

- 3.5.1. The Countries Ranking will be made following points 1.9 and 1.11 by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.
- 3.5.2. If a National Federation does not enrol its national team, the best two results by club following points 1.9 and 1.11 at each distance, at each category (men, women, junior and senior) will go for the Countries ranking.

6. Prizes

Individual prizes: medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.

Teams' prizes: cups for the first three clubs and cups for the first three National Teams.

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the involved athletes must be at the organizing staff's disposal at the right time.

During ceremonies awarded athletes must wear the official uniforms of their teams.













7. Antidoping

- WADA World Antidoping Code
- CMAS Antidoping Rules
- Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

Responsibility

The Organizing federation, the organizing committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge aren't responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.

8. Additional Note

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organizer's judgment. Participating teams will get all information about the changes in time.

Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their full equipment at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

9. Visa

If you need Visa to enter Colombia, please contact Colombian Federation (FEDECAS) via E-Mail <u>worldcupcolombia2024@gmail.com</u> not later than August 30th, 2024.

10. Enrolment

- 1. Preliminary entry the application form is provided as an attachment with these specific rules and must be filled duly (Enclosure 1 Preliminary Entry Form)
- 2. For registration of events, the website is https://www.sportdata.org/cmas . This is the only way to enter your registration to participate at the World Cup.

11. Accommodation and transportation

The organization recommend that each Team to reserve with the organizing committee the transportation of the arrival and departure from the International Airport, is the best option but, other option is the use of the official taxis from the airport or UBER or any similar App.

The Barranquilla International Airport is 25kms from the hotel and swimming pool.

















The price per person for transportation with the organization, from the airport to the hotel and return is **50 euro or 55 us dollars for 5 persons** or less and **30 euro or 35 us dollars for groups of 6 persons and more**.

For any participating clubs wish to arrive earlier to have training session a full board services are offered, paying the pro-rata charge as indicated above.

Swimming pool lanes are charged separately (20euro or 25 us dollars per line per hour).
