






GENERAL INFORMATION - LOCATION MAP

INFORMATION

1 CHAMPIONSHIPS RULES

- The CMAS general rules and CMAS Finswimming rules will be applied.
- The minimum age required to participate in CMAS Championships is: 15 years to participate in the World, Senior Championships and 14 years to participate at World Junior Championships. The maximum age required to participate in CMAS Junior Championships is 17 years.
- Each country may enter not more than four (4) swimmers for each distance and one (1) relay team by category. For the elimination race each country may enter not more than two (2) swimmers for each distance and one (1) relay team by category.
- The mixed relay team is necessarily composed of two female athletes and two male athletes. The starting order is fixed (men-women-men-women) and the composition is decided by the team leader.

2 CHAMPIONSHIPS EVENTS

- Individual (M&F): 1 km SF, 5 km SF, 1 km BF, 3 km BF, Elimination race 150 SF, Elimination race 150 BF
- Relay: 4x1 km SB mixed, Elimination race 4x150 SB mixed.

AWARDS

There will be awarded gold, silver and bronze medals for each distance in individual races and for each relay, for each age group for men and women (or mixed teams).

INTERNATIONAL JURY

CMAS Technical Delegate according to the CMAS rules.

DDOTESTS

According to the CMAS rules.

DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping tests may be conducted during the championship according to the international rules of WADA and the CMAS anti-doping code. The organizing committee guarantees to provide doping control according to the CMAS and WADA rules.

FLAGS

National teams should bring three (3) national flags (2 m x 1m) and a CD or USB with the national anthem (short version).

BOOKING & ENTRY FEES

1 - PACKAGE COMPETITION REGISTRATION AND ACCOMODATION (5 NIGHTS): LENTRY FEE PER PARTICIPANT: 790 €

DEADLINES FOR ENTRY AND PARTICIPATION

NO LATER THAN 15/08/2024

- A minimum of **50%** of the total entry fee should be deposited at the organization's bank account to guarantee the booking.
- Payment must be sent to the organizing committee, together with a copy of the bank transfer.
- After this date, the participation fees will increase by a further 10% of the total amount. The remaining payment should be paid upon arrival.

NO LATER THAN 09/09/2024

- Registration and total payment of CMAS fees.
- Inform the organizing committee of your arrival details if you need a transfer to the hotel should be sent to the organizing committee, together with a copy of the bank transfer.





ENROLMENTS

1. Registration

All registration of athletes for events must be submitted only through electronic way. Application forms can be used only for accommodation, general organization and other items proposed. For registration the website is https://www.sportdata.org/cmas

2. Registration short Tutorial

For registration you need an account.

For event registration of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials please follow these steps:

- On the bottom of the entries site you will see the functions to make new entries
- Register your competitors / teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees and officials

- All your registrations will go first on a waiting list in order to be validated. After the payment process is finished, your registrations will be approved and you will be notified by email.

3. Fees of registration

Each competitor must, in order to participate, pay the CMAS fees, fixed annually by CMAS.

• 48 € for participation fees (include annually temporary license).

Please note that the names of relay members must be entered during the registration process on the basis of individual registration even if they swim only in relay and even if, according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on site before the beginning of the competition.

These fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online. by credit card or bank transfer including SEPA.
