

1. Registration process

1. Fees of registration

a. CMAS Fees



For each round, in order to participate, each competitor is required to pay the CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS.

25,00 € for participation fees by each round (for 2025).

Please note that the names of relay members must be entered during the registration process on the base of individual registration even if they only swim relay and even according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on site before the beginning of competition.

These fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online, by credit card.

b. Miscellaneous

- Fees will not be refunded for non-participation of athletes in races.



- Penalties will apply for late enrolments after the deadline according to the registration planning.

c. Organisation Fees

The procedures of all expenditures regarding the competition (accommodation fee, inscription fees etc.) are paid directly to the organising committee according to the instructions communicated below:

Inscription fees for 2025 are:

- 25,00 € for each club;
- 18,00 € for each relay;
- 10,00 € for each individual distance;
- Fees will not be refunded for non-participation of athletes in races.
- Late enrolments are not accepted as registration is managed by the CMAS system during the registration planning.



2. Competition place

The competition will take place at:

Yves Blanc Swimming Pool, 26 avenue des Écoles Militaires, 13100 Aix en Provence

The swimming pool has a length of 50m, a width of 21 m and eight lanes 50 m and a depth from 2.00 m to 2.50 m. The temperature of the water is 26° C (+ 1° C).

AIX EN PROVENCE

Situated on highway A7 and route N7, 35 km from Marseille, 15 km from Aix TGV railway station and 30 km from Marseille-Marignane International Airport.

Protected by the Montagne Ste Victoire which rises to 1,011m. Aix with ancient fountains and shaded narrow streets is surrounded by a countryside full of authentic Provencal houses and traditional French style gardens.

Aix was the capitol of Provence in the 15th century. Wealthy merchants and local dignitaries helped turn this city into the Florence of Provence as we know it today. Aix was the inspiration to many of the greatest writers and painters: Guigou, Stendhal, Mistral, Zola, and Cézanne.





3. Timekeeping system

The timekeeper will conduct time recording through electronic time and recording system.

4. Checking equipment and bottle refills

The judges are authorized to check swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions. The general control of the equipment (fins, snorkels) and bottles will take place at the swimming pool on Friday, 7/02/2025 from 09:00 to 12:00.

Bottes will have to be delivered empty to the organization for the control.

The judges are authorized to control swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions.

All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition, or even less if it is required by the local legislation. They will not come accepted bottles with important signs of rust.

➤ Any equipment that does not comply with EN250 will not be allowed (Only medium pressure pipes (MP) to French standards mechanically crimped at the ends will be allowed - PROHIBITION of the clamp type "Serflex" or other similar device.

5. Classifications

Classifications will be based on times registered by the timekeepers, results will be complied according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

- 3.1. There will be classifications for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries
- 3.2. <u>Individual</u>: There will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for Senior and Junior, men and women. Swimmers registered by Clubs or National Teams are in this classification.
- 3.3. <u>Club</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification will be made also for senior men, senior women, junior boys and junior girls.
- 3.4. <u>National Teams</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification will be made also for men, women, junior boys and junior girls.
- 3.5. Countries Ranking:
 - 3.5.1. The Countries' Ranking will be made following points 1.9 and 1.11 by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.
 - 3.5.2. If a National Federation does not enrol its National team, the best two results by club following points 1.9 and 1.11 at each distance, at each category (men, women, junior and senior) will go for the Countries ranking.

6. Prizes

Individual prizes: medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.

Teams prizes: cups for the first three clubs and cups for the first three National Teams.

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the athletes involved must be at the organising staff's disposal at the right time.

During the award ceremonies the athletes must wear the official uniforms of their teams.

7. Antidoping

The Organising Federation, the organising committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.

8. Additional Note

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organiser's. Participating teams will be given all information regarding schedule changes.

Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their full equipment at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

- 2. Registration for events can only made through the CMAS Portal. This is the only way to enter your registration to participate at the World Cup.
