The Sport complex WCRS „Aquasfera” with 50 m swimming pool (10 lines with a width of 2,50 meters and 2,00 – 2,10 meters depth, average temperature 27 °C +/- 1 °C ) with about 1500 spectators seats.

The venue hosting the 2025 CMAS European Championship Finswimming Indoor meets all necessary technical and organizational requirements, ensuring comfort and safety for both athletes and judges.

The complex is equipped with all essential facilities, including:

- ✓ spacious locker rooms for athletes,
- ✓ showers and sanitary facilities,
- ✓ dedicated rooms for judges and organizers,
- ✓ a rest and warm-up area,
- ✓ designated spaces for technical teams and media.

The Championship will take place WCRS „Aquasfera“, Olsztyn, Poland, from 15th to 21st of July 2025.

## Information about Participation

Only participants with a CMAS license are eligible to compete in the Championship.

## Swimming Pool Events

Each country may enter a maximum of two swimmers per distance and one relay team.

For relay races the names of the swimmers and their starting order must appear in a list submitted to the results office before the start of the session. The composition of mixed relays is with two (2) males and two (2) females and starting order is Man-Woman-Man-Woman. For SB Mixed relay the starting order is Man BF – Woman BF – Men SF – Woman SF. National Teams may change relay team members between qualifying heats and finals.

Entries must be submitted to CMAS headquarters according to the procedure attached.

European Championship will occur over four days and eight sessions.

Qualifying heats will take place in the morning and finals in the afternoon, except for the 400M, 800M SF, and 1500M SF. For these, slow heats will be in the morning and fast heats in the afternoon.

National federations must send official protocols of all selection competitions to CMAS HQ within two weeks post-competition, in one of the three CMAS languages. This allows verification of swimmers' enrolment times for championships. If protocols are not received by the deadline, the corresponding enrolment times will be voided, and athletes will be registered with the placeholder time of 59:59:59.

## Doping Control

The organising committee guarantees to provide doping control according to the CMAS and WADA rules.

## Bottle Filing

Only compressed air without oxygen enrichment is allowed.

Minimum volume for a compressed air cylinder: 0.4 liter.

Maximum filling pressure: 200 bar (20 MPa).

When a cylinder with a flat bottom is used, adding a rounded bottom, which does not exceed the radius of the cylinder, is allowed.

All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than two (2) years before the Championship, or even less if it is required by the local legislation.

Each cylinder must be presented in good condition and empty during checking meeting before Championship.

The organiser guarantees the filing of DYN & INT cylinders. For all other types teams must bring their own adaptor.

## Flags

Each national team must bring two (2) national flags (m. 2,00 x m. 1,00).
